The location is approximately 20 miles west of Berwyn on Route 30. Google maps is a great place to get the map from, here are the directions from the 252 and Route 30 Intersection:

Drive: 19.4 mi – about 28 mins

1. Head west on E Lancaster Ave toward Paoli Shopping Center 2.4 mi - 4 mins
2. Slight left at Lancaster Ave/Lancaster Pike 3.5 mi - 6 mins
3. Turn left to merge onto US-30 W toward Downingtown 11.1 mi - 13 mins
4. Take the exit toward Coatesville Veterans Hospital - 433 ft
5. Turn left at Fisherville Rd 0.2 mi
6. Turn right at Reeceville Rd 1.6 mi - 3 mins
7. Turn left at E Reeceville Rd 0.4 mi - 1 min
